Canned Goods: meat, tuna, fruit, vegetables, tomato sauce, soup

Dry Goods: pasta, noodles, rice, beans, cereal, Jello, peanut butter, jam or jelly (non-breakable squeeze bottles)

ITEMS NOT NEEDED

NO glass jars or bottles

NO liquids in boxes

NO perishables

NO junk food

NO leftover Passover items

Donations will be taken to Elizabeth House in Laurel. Please be sure to check expiration dates. Elizabeth House volunteers will discard all food that is expired.
